Karate Masters is a combined WKF- and SHOBU IPPON competition in the same Arena. Karate Masters is a competition wherein you compete in both systems on the same day. All styles, organisations, clubs, and countries are welcome. Karate Masters also has classes in Kumite for Cadets, Juniors, and Seniors.

Furthermore, Karate Masters features all belt classes and Kata / Kumite classes for children aged 7 to 13 years old. Moreover, Karate Masters features Master Classes in Kata, for both age groups 40+ and 50+ in Dan / Open class. Trophies are awarded to the winners of each category and all children will receive a participation medal.
